

WooTank is an intercollegiate pitch competition held in Worcester, MA, where student entrepreneurs from local colleges present their business ventures to a panel of investors, aiming to secure real-time funding and mentorship. The event is organized by The Venture Forum, a startup community dedicated to fostering economic growth and supporting entrepreneurs in Central MA.



The inaugural WooTank Intercollegiate Showdown was held on April 2nd, 2024 and was a huge success. Over the course of the evening, eight student-run companies pitched their innovative business ideas to a panel of sharks to try to get one or more of them to allocate funding into their venture. Negotiations took place in real time on the stage, with over \$20K of direct funding and

in-kind services awarded to the competitors. Sponsors included Webster Five, Geisel Software, MassVentures, WorcLab, Mike Mitchell Consulting and Credence Web Services.
